1. Work from home policy.

 - a) Infiltration

Update

Funds / Subsidies

a) Gas Tax Fund

Pointe du Chêne and Shediac Cape Sanitary Sewer Improvements

Contract 1 – LS No. 9 and LS No. 14 upgrades: Chris Gallant mentioned that the contractor expects the work will start by the end of the month.

Contract 2 - PDC sewer main renewal: Chris Gallant mentioned that the contractor expects the work will start by the end of the month.

3. Cap-Brulé WWTP upgrades.

Chris Gallant mentioned that Englobe Corp. sent a letter, dated August 11, 2022, to the Regional Development Corporation, detailing the tender results, the funding presently available, the costs savings possible by reviewing certain elements of Phase 1, and the requested additional funding to be able to complete the project. The RDC responded in an email dated August 12 that they will determine how much additional funding they can allocate. The director, operations, added that the GSSC shouldn't award the contract for phase 1, headworks building, until we receive written confirmation that additional funding will be available for the second phase. The members agreed.

Sanitary sewer service repairs, Monique Street

The director, operations, has conducted a final walk through this afternoon with a representative from Englobe Corp. and the contractor. There is no update from our lawyer on the legal matter.
